

### Kangaroo, I Love You!




### **Marsupial Mask**


# **Sewing Sow**

# Pick a Pig



# Soft Sheep


Glue cotton balls to the sheep. Then, cut it out and glue it onto a large construction paper to decorate and create a meadow scene.

## F is for Fox








## **Foxy Fashion**








## **Playful Pandas**


Cut the pandas out and hide them all over your play area. You can write numbers on the pandas for number practice.





## Hop to It







# Hare-Raising Sports Charades
