General Plan/ approach

Each grantee directly operating an early head start or Head start program must establish and maintain a Health Services Advisory Committee (HSAC), Which include Head start parents, professionals, and other volunteers from the community.

Head Start Program Performance Standards: 1302.40 (b) – Health Services Advisory Committee

Procedure:

- The role of the HSAC is to advise in the planning, operation, and evaluation of health services
- The HSAC assist in planning, accessing community health resources, and development of policies and procedures
- HSAC members are recruited through personal contact, policy contact or community outreach
- Appropriate members include physicians, nurses, dentists, dieticians, WIC, audiologist, optometrist, mental health professionals, allied health professionals, coordinated care provider representatives, and parents
- HASC members may be consulted during the year as needs arise
